Press Release: Additional information

The Sawyer County Sheriff's office is releasing additional information on the April 22, 2011 incident which happened at the Bacon Square residence on the Lac Courte Oreilles Reservation.

The deceased subject has been identified as John B."J.B." Mc Daniel age 23. An autopsy was performed by the Ramsey County MN Medical Examiner's officer and John McDaniel's manner of death has been ruled a Homicide due to Exsanguination from multiple stab wounds.

Derrick McDaniel who is the brother of the deceased was critically injured with multiple stab wounds and is currently being treated in a Duluth Hospital.

A third individual who is a Juvenile was injured during the incident and is also being treated in a Duluth, MN Hospital.

Two adults have been arrested in connection with the incident. Caleb Michael Miller age 18 and Marvin Alex Corbine Jr. age 20 have been charged with party to the crime of Homicide and party to the crime of Attempted Homicide. Corbine was injured during the event and was treated and released from the Hayward Area Memorial Hospital on Friday and was taken into custody Friday afternoon. Both subjects are being held in the Sawyer County Jail on \$50,000 cash bonds.

Investigators worked through the weekend interviewing numerous subjects and have identified 7 individuals including Caleb Miller and Marvin Corbine who went to the McDaniel residence at approximately 4:30 Friday morning. Specific details of the incident are not being released to preserve the integrity of the investigation.

Additional charges are being considered and will be referred to the Sawyer County District Attorney. Two of the individuals involved are juveniles and they will be referred to Sawyer County Human Services.

On Saturday Evening Officers recovered instruments that were believed to have been utilized in the crimes.

There are rumors in the community that this was a gang related incident. The victims in this case have never been identified to law enforcement as to having any gang affiliations.
