Senate Wraps Up Fall Session

Madison- Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu (R-Oostburg) issued the following statement after the state Senate's floor action today:

"This has been a productive fall session. After delivering the second largest income tax cut in state history during the budget, the Senate moved to stop property tax hikes by repealing Governor Evers' 400-year veto, lower prices at the store by fighting organized retail theft, and reduce healthcare costs by expanding access to cost-effective telehealth services.

"While Democrats push legislation to increase taxes and grow government, Senate Republicans are hyper-focused on lowering costs for hardworking Wisconsin families."

The Senate's next scheduled floor period is in January.
